

# Attention: High School Seniors...Scholarship Information 2012 Texas 4-H Foundation Scholarship



If you haven't already started, now is the time to begin working toward scholarship application requirements.

The Texas 4-H Foundation scholarship applications will be due on <u>February 1, 2012</u> to the Gregg County Extension Office, so...now is the time to get started on your scholarship application so that you are not working on it "at the last minute". Last minute preparations are not sufficient in order to achieve an outstanding scholarship application! The 2012 Texas 4-H Foundation Scholarship Application is available on the Texas 4-H website which is <a href="http://texas4-H.tamu.edu/youth/scholarship">http://texas4-H.tamu.edu/youth/scholarship</a>. So <u>NOW</u> is the time for graduating senior 4-H members to begin preparing to complete the scholarship application.

IMPORTANT! IMPORTANT! The Texas 4-H Foundation Scholarship application process now requires the "FAFSA" (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to be included with the scholarship application. High School seniors should start immediately with either the on-line or paper process. It takes approximately 4 weeks to receive your report from FAFSA that must be included in your application that is due by February 1, 2012. The website for the FAFSA is www.fafsa.ed.gov.

#### Minimum Requirements for the Texas 4-H Foundation Scholarship

#### For Baccalaureate Scholarships

- Minimum SAT score of 1350 and/or minimum ACT score of 19 (Test Scores must be from a single date-no combining of scores from different test dates).
- Completed and passed all necessary standardized test(s) for graduation and admittance to the college and/or university declared in the scholarship application.
- Have been accepted into a Texas college or university by the time of scholarship awarding.

#### For Technical Scholarships

- Completed and passed all necessary standardized test(s) for graduation and admittance to the college and/or university declared in the scholarship application.
- Have been accepted into a Texas college or university by the time of scholarship awarding.
- DO NOT have plans to continue formal education at a Texas college and/or university after the completion of a technical program.

Applications will also be available from the HLSR website at www.rodeohouston.com. Applications must be submitted both online and by mail to the HOUSTON LIVESTOCK SHOW & RODEO by January 15, 2012. Graduating public high school students are eligible to apply. Required for eligibility is a minimum SAT score of 1350 and/or a minimum ACT score of 19.

Ribbons will be given to the top five places in each age division as appropriate.

#### **CHANGES FOR 2012:**

The following educational presentations will replace those listed above: Open- Agriculture and Natural Resources and Open – Family and Consumer Sciences

Swine Skill-a-Thon will be changed to an invitational style contest.

Invitational Swine Quiz Bowl will be open to intermediates and seniors.

Invitational Meats Contest will be hosted on Thursday June 14, 2012 for intermediate and seniors not participating in the qualifying Meat Judging and Identification Contest.

4-H members winning first place in a Fashion Storyboard category may participate in a different category the following year.

Modifications have been made to the Livestock Sweepstakes and Healthy Lifestyles Sweepstakes.

Highlights of the new 4-H recordbook include:

- Different forms for each age group based on age appropriateness (Junior, Intermediate, Senior progressive in nature)
- Added goal setting section for Junior & Intermediates
- No more recordbook objectives
- No more resume for Seniors
- Added Career Exploration section for Seniors
